Notification 1 - "Brake System Problem - The brake system has a problem or the brake fluid may be low. Press the brake pedal lightly to check brake pressure. If there is no resistance from the brake pedal, downshift to lower gears to slow the vehicle. Immediately stop in a safe place and contact roadside assistance".

Dealers will replace the steering gearbox assembly free of charge to resolve the concern. "

This is a 2010 Honda Accord LX, with 130,000 miles on it. I replaced the power steering pump, reservoir, and fluid (with genuine Honda power steering fluid) at around 120,000 miles. I was trying to make the steering



wheel less stiff (especially at low speeds).
