If the outage is momentary, or less than an hour or so, check the circuit breaker to make certain that the breaker was not tripped by the outage. When the rare ice or wind storm takes out the electricity for a day or more, aerobic system owners are advised not to use their system as this will eventually cause a backup in the



system.

First let"s silence the alarm; there should be a switch or button on the control box that will do that. (Post a photo of your control box and I may be able to comment further). An septic alarm might sound for up to 30 minutes after power has been off to the system, but if the alarm is sounding longer than that more action is needed.
