I turned the car on and off a couple of times but it still said the same thing until about 10 minutes after that it was all fine.

My battery died and I had to jump start it and now my computer screen says anti-theft system the system has lost power push and hold the power button for more than 2 seconds to enable the system. ... If You need to reset the alarm system on a Honda CR-V it is a pretty easy thing to do. All You will need to do is put the vehicle in the on position with the engine off. After that You will want to press the alarm button three times. You can find this button in the driver's footwell near the parking brake. When You do it right You will hear the horn honk twice.
