I'm guessing you may have the same issue. Honda always had an anti-theft code to unlock the car or reenable after losing power and I'm guessing the push button is similar to the radio aspect. So I would have Honda check your power connections for the battery. This is also likely why you could not use remote or power tailgate / doors.

The anti-theft system on a Honda Civic is used to immobilize the engine when a key that is not programmed to the vehicle is attempted to be used. It is one of the best systems on the market and virtually impossible to hack.

I have a 2011 2WD SE that was originally from Arizona and had one of the KARR after market security systems put in which was preventing the car from starting. I've removed that system and now the car still won't start. When I turn the key to run, the anti-theft light flashes and so does the check engine light.
