To test the battery, it should be charged on a good Firestorm three-hour charger (do not use any other charger). The battery only needs to be put on the charger for two minutes (this will not damage the charger if only done for two minutes). After charging for two minutes its nominal voltage should be reached (example: 9.6 volt will read 9.6 volt).

The other blink pattern on a 40v Black and Decker charger is a series of rapid, short blinks. In this case, the light indicates a bad battery. When your power source is damaged, or too weak, it will trip this reaction in

your charger. As a result, you should remove it immediately and stop trying to charge it.

A rapid flashing red light indicates a bad or damaged battery - do not continue to charge - return to service center or collection site for recycling. A long flash then a short flash indicates an excessively hot or cold battery and charger automatically switches to the pac charging mode, this ensures maximum battery life.
