How old is the Battery you have in the car right now, if your car is a '57 plate then it could quite possibly have the OEM Battery (a black top Panasonic make), if it is then you have done well with it, if not then there should be a date stamp somewhere on the Battery and that is the first thing I would investigate to ensure is 100% for your (electric) power steering problem.
