Solar power can provide your home with clean, renewable energy for decades. Since solar equipment lasts so long, you may be wondering, "What happens if my solar company goes out of business and I need service?" With stiff competition among an ever-growing number of installers, many solar companies have declared solar bankruptcy or stopped operating.

In 2023, the solar industry witnessed a significant number of contractors going out of business, a trend fueled by a confluence of economic and policy-driven factors. : The Federal Reserve raised interest rates to combat inflation, inadvertently affecting the solar sector.

During a downturn in the market, many solar companies fail and go out of business. For example, in 2000 about 8,700 unique companies installed at least one system for residential use; by the end of 2016, there were only 2,900 active installers left. This means two-thirds have faced bankruptcy or simply disappeared due to lack of demand from ...

Dozens of other solar firms have failed this year as well, including Infinity Energy, Solcius, and Kayo Energy. "We pretty much have a \$70,000 roof ornament at this point," says Jasmine Hendrickson, who had a system installed by Pink Energy a week before the company went out of business.

Coatesville Solar is in a slightly easier situation, as it's filing for Chapter 11 bankruptcy, which allows for a debtor to reorganize its liabilities and restructure itself to continue operations.

The supply chain for solar components might experience fluctuations due to altered demand patterns. Industry consolidation might occur, with larger players absorbing defunct companies' client base and assets. Homeowners may worry about the longevity and maintenance of their solar systems.

The solar industry has been a beacon of hope for a sustainable future, but not all companies have been able to withstand the economic pressures. Recently, Titan Solar Power, once a major player in the solar energy market, has declared bankruptcy and is going out of business.

It is not rare for a solar company to go out of business and for its leases to be acquired by another firm; around 8,700 different companies installed at least one residential solar system between ...

SunPower, the company that provides the solar panels many Coachella Valley residents have on their roofs, filed for bankruptcy on Monday. It is the latest development in a saga that has seen the ...
