The new 18v battery will drive old Ryobi 14.4 volt tools but you have to cut/modify the battery socket holder as there are slight changes so you cannot plug immediately one into the other. And yes the lithium battery really only should charge in a lithium charger. Ive just got an old 14.4 volt ryobi saw to work very well with new 18v lithium ...

Yes, Ryobi ONE Plus 18 volt batteries do work in the older blue 18-volt Ryobi tools. And for this I am thankful. I don't have to save up for brand new tools, and I don't have to send my old tools to the scrap yard.

Thankfully Ryobi has made their new lithium ion 18v ONE Plus batteries backwards compatible so these new batteries do work in older 18v Ryobi tools. It will help keep lots of perfectly fine tools out of the landfill.

They made the batteries backwards compatible with their old tools. This means you can buy a new 18 volt battery - a lithium battery - and use it in your older 18v Ryobi tools. I was happy to learn this because even though my tools were older they still worked well.

The beauty of these tools is they work great on the new l-ion batteries. You will need the charger for the L-ion batteries (old charger isn"t compatible) but if you get the right charger it will do the old ni-cads as well as the l-ion batteries. No real point in using the old ni-cads though. They suck. I have everyone of those tools and still

There was only one 4V and 12V battery that was still being used by Ryobi. The 4V battery is used for Ryobi's line of 4V tools, which was pretty small and only consists of 3 power screwdrivers and an inspection camera.
