

Honda odyssey 2018 anti theft system lost power

If you value the infotainment system a lot don't get the 2018 odyssey. I have a 2018 and it has been constant various issues. Front screen goes black. Tuner not working. Dvd won't play. My rear screen cable is now worn out so only displays if wire is in just right spot. Front screen is black when using remote start. Backup camera doesn't display.

To reset the anti theft system on a honda odyssey you will need to hold the panic button for 5 seconds and press the lock button twice. 2019 Odyssey... Turn on vehicle ... Press and hold audio power button until system reactivates. See page 166 Customer Information.

In a few words: The immobilizer or anti-theft system verifies that the key used to turn the engine on is the correct one. If the key is not the correct one, this system blocks different actions to prevent the car from starting. When this system is activated on your Odyssey a warning light such as the one below will turn on:

There were some reports on here of people losing all power while driving and other issues electrical which seemed to be related to a lose battery cable. I'm guessing you may have the same issue. Honda always had an anti-theft code to unlock the car or reenable after losing power and I'm guessing the push button is similar to the radio aspect.

If your car's anti-theft system isn't working correctly, you'll need to find a way to shut the system off so your car will return to normal operation. Method 1 of 3: Check your key and cylinder. Step 1: Check your key fob battery. A car's anti-theft system may activate if your key fob battery is dead and hasn't disabled the system.

The Honda anti-theft system seems to be available for the Honda Civic and Honda Accord models. You can check if your car has this security feature by reading the car's user manual. It should detail all the necessary information about how to use the anti-theft feature.
