Disconnect Backup Battery

Hello, I'm hoping to get some professional advice as to how I can remove power to the existing home security system without setting off any alarms or the fire sprinklers or calling the fire department/police. I just bought a townhome and it has this system installed which the previous owner (6 years) never used either.

AC power is provided to a security system through a plug-in transformer. You must run a wire between the transformer and the alarm panel to transmit power. This is a big step in setting up a system. An alarm system will also have a backup battery to provide power during electrical outages.. AC power represents the primary power source for an alarm system.

There are a couple of ways you can reset your alarm panel. The simplest is to power it down and then power it back on, which is called a power reset. Open up the panel and look for the power button. Hold it down until the panel turns off and there aren't any lights on. Wait a few seconds and then power it back on by pressing the button again.

An alarm's keypad, such as this Honeywell model, controls your alarm system, but it does not have the parts you need to power your alarm down. Additionally, some alarm systems have smoke and fire detection on them.
