How to ship a lithium battery

There are regulations attached to the cross-border shipping of batteries to ensure they travel safely. These regulations vary depending on the type of batteries. Lithium batteries, for example, are classified as Dangerous Goods, so not all types of lithium batteries are accepted by DHL Express which you can check here.

Learn how to ship lithium ion batteries on shippingschool. Lithium ion batteries are categorized in Class 9 of Hazardous Materials, so you'll need to follow certain regulations if you want to ship them domestically and internationally. Effective 1 July 2015, all existing customers and new customers who wish to ship lithium metal batteries without equipment (UN3090) via UPS ® Air services must obtain pre-approval from UPS Airlines. This requirement is to ensure that proper training has occurred and that all applicable safety regulations are properly followed for such shipments.

"Lithium ion batteries, in compliance with Section II of PI967"on AWB. A telephone number is no longer required on the lithium battery mark. Lithium battery marks with a phone number may continue to be applied until December 31, 2026. NOTE: the requirement to apply lithium battery mark does not apply to: -- packages containing only button cell

For shipping lithium batteries with USPS overseas, you can ship a maximum of 4 cells or 2 batteries that are installed in the new or certified refurbished equipment or device it operates, without any lithium battery markings. However, individual batteries are prohibited from USPS international shipping.

USPS has official instructions and guidelines for shipping batteries. ShipSaving helps you to highlight the following information: All packages containing lithium metal or lithium-ion batteries that can be mailed must be of sufficient size, sealed, and rigid. This ensures that the lithium battery mark can be affixed to the address without folding.

Lithium-Ion battery shipping regulations. When shipping L i-ion batteries via air, sea, rail, or road, compliance with the United Nations Standard 38.3 is a critical requirement. This standard, a part of the UN Manual of Tests and Criteria, applies to both standalone batteries and those integrated into devices.

UPS will ship lithium ion batteries for 48 US states, excluding Alaska, Hawaii, and Puerto Rico. However, they have restrictions on damaged, defective, or recalled batteries and require pre-approval for shipping.

Transport Document: For lithium battery shipments, this specifies the UN number, shipping name, hazard class, packing group, and total quantity. Pilot Notification: For shipping lithium batteries by air, pilots must receive written information on the presence and location of lithium batteries.

Any package bearing a lithium battery shipping label should also be marked as dangerous goods and have the necessary documentation; It may be necessary to use specialized packaging to ensure the safety; Lithium Metal Batteries These are batteries that use lithium as an anode. They have a long life and can produce anywhere between 1.5V-3.7V.

Lithium batteries are defined in international regulations and by many transport companies as a hazardous material (HazMat). This applies to both Lithium Metal batteries (disposable) and Lithium Ion batteries (rechargeable), even though the latter do not actually contain lithium. The restrictions apply not strictly because of the lithium content, but because ...

USPS Packaging Instruction 9E Lithium Metal and Lithium-ion Cells and Batteries -- International and APO/FPO/DPO. Lithium metal (non-rechargeable) cells and batteries and lithium-ion (rechargeable) cells and batteries are mailable in limited quantities internationally or to and from APO, FPO, or DPO locations only when they are properly installed in the equipment they operate.

Lithium batteries are commonly used in devices like mobile phones, laptops, PDAs, watches, cameras, and even children's toys. Lithium battery shipments or shipments with items that contain charged batteries may overheat and ignite in certain conditions and, once ignited, may be ...
