Per UPS guidelines, air shipments must also include the following statement: "Lithium ion battery - PI 965, Section II". Properly packaged and labeled lithium battery shipments comply with national and airline regulations, ensuring safe transit to destinations like Hawaii.

For lithium battery shipments to Hawaii, the bill of lading must clearly identify the batteries and quantity, and indicate they are fully regulated Class 9 hazardous materials. The document helps ensure all cargo handlers are aware of the shipment contents and any risks.

Although battery types like lithium metal batteries, lithium-ion batteries and others are all technically different, for the purposes of shipping they are largely seen as the same and all rules, recommendations, and restrictions generally apply to all types.
