These people may contact you through door-to-door visits, phone calls, or emails. They will make enticing claims about new tax credits, time-limited incentives, or dramatic savings on electricity bills.

Keep records: Keep detailed records of all communication with your chosen solar company, including emails and phone calls. FAQ. Who regulates solar companies in AZ? In Arizona, solar companies are regulated by the Commission that oversees investor-owned or privately-owned utilities providing gas, water, electricity, or telephone service.

SCAMwatch is warning Australians to continue to be wary of scammers who offer bogus government rebates for the installation of solar panels. How the scam works: You receive an unexpected call, email or house visit from someone offering either free solar panels or a government rebate/grant on solar panels following an upfront payment.

That is, of course, also a scam. To protect yourself from clean energy scams: Know that "free" or "no cost" solar panel offers are scams. The federal government does not install solar systems in homes for free.
