When shipping lithium batteries, businesses must comply with U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) standards and Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) standards for preparing shipments ...

United States Parcel Service (USPS) published a notice in the Federal Register that describes revisions to USPS Publication 52, Hazardous Restricted, and Perishable Mail. These revisions closely align USPS requirements for shipping lithium cells and batteries with those found in both the U.S. D.O.T. and international regulations.

Except as provided above, individual lithium metal (or lithium alloy) and lithium-ion (or lithium polymer) batteries (without equipment) are mailable in limited quantities via surface transportation only, provided the batteries are in the originally sealed packaging, and packaged and marked as described in 349.221 and

349.222, as applicable.

Except for mailpieces containing button cell batteries properly installed in the equipment they are intended to operate, mailpieces containing mailable lithium metal or lithium-ion batteries must be rigid, sealed, and of adequate size, so the lithium battery mark can be affixed to the address side without the mark being folded.

3 days ago· 3. International Restrictions: International battery shipments have more stringent regulations due to safety concerns. USPS prohibits shipping lithium batteries internationally via mail. However, you can send other non-spillable and spillable batteries internationally, subject to specific packaging requirements and restrictions imposed by the destination country.

I'm getting ready to sell a laptop on eBay, and I noticed that eBay suggests shipping via Priority Mail. I was under the impression that devices with lithium ion batteries can't be shipped Priority, even if they are installed in their original device.

If you're mailing pre-owned, damaged, or defective electronic devices containing or packaged with lithium batteries, you must send them via ground transportation; they are prohibited in air transportation.

If your laptop has a lithium battery, you have to use a special label that indicates that your package contains lithium batteries. You can get this label from a postal store or online. The label should have the words "Lithium Battery" and "UN 3481" on it, ...

Air shipments, including Priority Mail and Priority Mail Express, can include a maximum of 2 batteries or 8 cells when they contain standalone lithium ion cells or batteries, or lithium cells or batteries packed with or contained in equipment.

If not, securely package your item using non-Priority Mail shipping materials (USPS does not permit the use of Priority Mail shipping materials to ship a Ground Advantage shipment) and attach your shipping label to the box.
