



What to do if solar company goes out of business

If your solar company goes out of business, your equipment will still be covered by the manufacturer. Loan payments shouldn't change. Monalee is waiving the security deposit (\$100 value) on new solar projects.

Unfortunately, some solar companies are going out of business or even declaring bankruptcy. When solar installation companies close, customers are often left in a difficult position, unsure how to maintain their PV systems, manage solar equipment warranties, or find support for solar repairs and monitoring.

If your service provider goes out of business and isn't immediately acquired by another company, one of the first things you should do is reach out to your solar panel manufacturer, said Michael Skipper, a service coordinator at Exact Solar.

With stiff competition in a changing industry, solar companies do declare bankruptcy or stop operating. This guide covers the causes of solar company bankruptcy, and what to do if your solar installer goes out of business.

If your solar installation has been left unfinished and your company has gone out of business, completing solar installation quickly becomes a top priority. Begin by reviewing your contractual obligations to understand the terms and what was left incomplete.
