For rechargeable batteries, like the ones used cell phones, remote controls, and cameras, most retailers that sell them are required to accept and recycle them. As for batteries that are used for cars or golf carts, they are simply banned from landfills.

Single-use batteries do not contain heavy metals, which limits their recycling market. You may have to pay for recycling. Rechargeable batteries are used in everything from portable electronics to hybrid cars.

How, and where, to properly dispose of common batteries can be confusing. Here is what you need to know. First and foremost: do not place batteries in your recycling bin or cart. EPA recommendation: Contact the manufacturer, automobile dealer or company that installed the Li-ion battery for management options; do not put it in the trash or municipal recycling bins. Because of the size and complexity of these battery systems, medium and large-scale Li-ion batteries may not be able to be removed by the consumer.

Making sure these smaller lithium-ion batteries get collected and recycled will support the growing battery recycling industry in the U.S. Sending end-of-life batteries for recycling also keeps them out of the household garbage and recycling systems, where they can start fires and endanger workers and nearby communities.

You can take your used batteries to designated collection points such as local authorities, civic amenity sites, retailers, and waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) recycling sites that hold an ABTO license. How to Recycle Right. The first rule in managing batteries safely is to always follow the manufacturer's instructions. Here are additional tips on preparing batteries for recycling. Collect and sort your batteries by type (e.g., lithium-ion, alkaline). Put on latex gloves to avoid any possible contact with powder or acid that can burn your skin.

Batteries contain toxic chemicals and metals, including lead, mercury, zinc and lithium, that can pollute the environment. Many of these elements can be safely extracted and reused in new batteries, lighting, and more. If that wasn't a good enough reason, Ecosurety will donate £100 for every tonne of batteries donated.
